Medicaid QMB—pays 20% of Medicare bill and the Medicare Part B monthly premium and deductible (insurance coverage for the elderly and/or disabled who meet financial criteria)

Medicaid SLMB—pays the Medicare Part B monthly premium (has financial criteria)
Medicaid Q1-1--- pays the Medicare Part B monthly premium (you cannot have both
a DADS Provider and Q1-1) (has financial criteria)

Transportation

SSI Medicaid (not QMB Medicaid) has transportation for medical appointments; each Medicaid Insurance company for Harris County has their transportation; state number is 1-877-MED- TRIP call M-F 8:00pm-5:00pm

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Government Information

Medicare

For people who have worked 40 quarters and put into federal Medicare program and who meet the criteria for access, either through the retirement age or disability approval; insurance that pays for 80% of approved Medicare expenses; 1-800-Medicare (1-800-633-4227) or www.medicare.gov.

Medicaid

For people who have not worked 40 quarters and/or put into the federal Medicare program and who meet the criteria for use, financial and/or functional abilities (disability with income/assets less than yearly set criteria); insurance that pays approved medical expenses; in Harris County you must enroll in an insurance program for Medicaid; this type of Medicaid is called SSI Medicaid as it is a full insurance unlike QMB Medicaid that only covers 20% of Medicare approved expenses or is a supplement to Medicare. 1-800-633-4227

Social Security

Disability —

SSDI is given to people who meet the criteria of having worked at least 40 quarters and put into the federal system and who are now unable to work due to illness or injury for the duration of life and they are under the age of 65 (Medicare eligibility age); after on SSDI for 2 years.

SSI -

given to people who have not worked the 40 quarters and who are now unable to work due to illness or injury for a long period of extended time; you can also obtain SSI if you are elderly and

meet the financial criteria.

Dependent —

is given to a person who is a child (can go into adulthood) of a person who put into the social security system; child must meet the disabled criteria and they receive a monthly

check based on the person's reported income.

Survivor

is a person who is a child or widow (er) of a person who put into the social security system; child receives benefits until their 18th birthday; widow(er) receives benefits until they remarry; person receives a monthly check based on the deceased person's reported income.
